Programme Notes

Friday

We will provide the '*Big Foot Trail*' which younger participants are able to go around with their leaders to familiarise themselves with the show ground.

The rock stage event is aimed at Scouts and Explorer Scout participants.

Saturday

There will be 20 activity zones across the event site offering a large range of activities for all sections. Some adventurous activities may have to be age or height restricted. There will be a 1 hour break for lunch and to reset equipment on the zones when participants will return to their campsites.

The Beaver Scout '*Big Foot Party*' is a staged event aimed at Beaver Scout participants. It will be an interactive, fun staged event. All activity zones will continue during the party.

The evening will begin with a traditional outdoor *camp fire* followed by our *camp city night life experience* including a range of entertainments, small shows, cinemas and games. There will be a '*Live at Big Camp*' show on the main stage aimed at Scouts and Explorer scouts.

Sunday

All 20 activity zones will open again on the Sunday from 10.00am. The main stage will host a special '*Big Foot Party*' event for Cub Scouts at 4.00pm whilst the rest of the zones continue.

The evening programme features a *carnival* with participants getting dressed up and parading from various starting points to the campfire area for a '*Great Get Together*' opening ceremony where we will celebrate Scouting in West Yorkshire. There follows the '*Great Get Together Carnival*' itself where there will be a fairground and side stalls provided by each Scout Group bringing one side show game to contribute to the whole event. Participants will be able to earn camp currency to be able to get their *Big Foot Award*. The *Great Get Together Rock Concert* will also be running on the main stage.

Monday

After breakfast, all participants will be encouraged to take part in the *Big Camp, Big Foot's Dash* – a sponsored run with fun obstacles and a few surprises on the way round. Participants will be able to choose which obstacles they want to tackle, how many times round the course they want to go and whether to run or walk the course. There will be medals for all at the end. This is our chance to help other people by being sponsored.
